ABSTRACT

Hong Kong is the definitive high-rise city of the world. Residential development in this city has been commonly organised in the form of high-rise housing estates. These housing estates often provide a range of community services and facilities for meeting daily needs. In particular, shopping centres of different scales operate in these estates, depending on the population sizes, that is, the clientele. These centres are not only designed to meet daily needs, but also provide entertainment, recreation and socialisation opportunities. It may also contribute to community development, identity shaping and break segregation between and among housing estates. However, its physical form may also be used as a segregating device, creating gated communities. This talk will present research findings on the above social functions of these neighbourhood shopping centres.
